DEPARTMENT OF ACCIDENT AND EMERGENCY

"Always be Ready, Alert and Prepared". - Matthew 24:44

The Accident and Emergency (A&E) department of Scudder Memorial Hospital, Ranipet serves as a crucial lifeline, often being the first point of contact for individuals facing medical emergencies. Scudder Memorial Hospital has earned a reputation for providing exceptional healthcare services, with its A&E department standing out as a beacon of efficiency and compassion.

Scudder Memorial Hospital's A&E department is equipped with state-of-the-art facilities designed to handle a wide array of medical emergencies. From trauma cases to critical illnesses, the hospital is committed to providing immediate and effective care.



The department boasts cutting-edge diagnostic equipment, including advanced imaging tools, ensuring swift and accurate assessments.



In 2010, the Emergency Department began its journey with a modest four-bedded unit under the leadership of Dr. Alwin Vinodh, Senior Consultant, Department of Orthopaedics. Over the years, the department has witnessed remarkable growth and development. Currently, the Accident and Emergency Department is headed by ED Consultant Dr. Immanuel Sathish, an experienced professional with expertise in Accident and Emergency medicine.

SMH's Emergency Department is a fully equipped facility that caters to various medical emergencies, including Medical, Cardio, Surgical, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Paediatric, Trauma cases and Mass casualties.

The department boasts 16 beds, with separate facilities for Resuscitation Room and observation. The allocation of specific bays for Trauma and Neuro Trauma, Paediatric, General Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynecology, and an isolated Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI) bay during pandemic reflects the department's commitment to providing specialized care.





The A&E department at SMH is equipped with modern medical technologies to ensure accurate and prompt diagnosis and treatment. Bedside ultrasound screening (E-FAST), digital X-ray, CT scans, laboratory services, and a blood storage unit contribute to the department's diagnostic capabilities. The Emergency Department also boasts a dedicated polytrauma team comprising General Surgeons, Orthopedic Surgeons, Neuro Surgeons, ENT specialists, and Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons, ensuring comprehensive care around the clock.

One of the notable achievements of SMH's A&E department is its distinction as having the second-highest number of registered trauma cases in the Ranipet district. This underscores the department's effectiveness in responding to and managing critical cases, showcasing the commitment and expertise of the medical and nursing staff.

ED is committed to creating an academic environment dedicated to teaching and learning modern Emergency Medicine. The department conducts various training programs, including Mass Casualty Mock Drills, Basic Life Support for Nurses and Paramedics, Advanced Cardiac Life Support training, disaster management training for hospital staff, Continuing Medical Education (CME) programs, and Workshops on Airway Management.

The success of the A&E department at SMH is attributed to a skilled and committed team. The department is staffed by four junior emergency medical officers, namely Dr. Sharon Priyadarshini, Dr. Eveline Mani Christy, Dr. Prema Vani, and Dr. Eswari. Additionally, the department boasts 18 well-trained nursing staff, one paramedic, and five housekeeping staff, all led by the senior Nursing Incharge Mr. Zakariah, and Mrs. Judith Kalpana.

Looking ahead, SMH's A&E department has ambitious plans to further enhance its services and educational initiatives. The department aims to initiate a Master in Emergency Medicine (MEM) course, providing specialized education and training for aspiring emergency medicine professionals. Plans also include expanding prehospital ambulance care services and launching Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS) training programs to empower the community with life-saving skills.

Scudder Memorial Hospital's Accident and Emergency Department has evolved into a beacon of hope and care for the community of Ranipet. The department's growth, advanced facilities, and dedicated team reflect its commitment to providing exceptional emergency medical services. With a focus on education and expansion, the future holds promising developments for SMH's A&E department as it continues to play a pivotal role in ensuring the health and well-being of the community.




