
"In the 1870 Annual Medical Report we read "The Gospel has been regularly preached at the dispensary."

"When a goodly number is gathered, a portion of scripture is read and the truth made known as simply and clearly as possible."

"We know that through this preaching many, many thousands have heard of Christ Jesus, the savior of the world"

"The great work continued and prospered through the years. God being faithful raised up many men and women to serve him thus, and men and women coming forward in response to His Call."

God has sent many faithful men and women to serve in the hospital as ministers of His word. They have been dedicated missionaries, working



The first person who joined the hospital was Mrs. Muthuvelu, as a Bible woman from 1921-1926.

Miss Kitty Ebenezer, joined as a full time worker in June 1958, the First Woman Evangelist. She established the Department of Religious work. She also started a Religious library with books in English, Tamil, Telugu and Urdu so that any patient could read the Gospel stories. In her visits to the ward she introduced the flannel graph board, making the stories and lessons more vivid and memorable. The use of a record player was also introduced, allowing patient to hear Lyrics and in Tamil and Telugu. Miss Kitty Ebenezer retired in 1965.




In 1961 a new chapel was opened by Dr. G. F. Scudder. It was built for Rs20,600, of which Rs 9,000/- was given by Mrs. De Wolf. This was from the proceeds of the sale of a house owned by Miss. J. C Scudder at Coonor. Scudder Association, Miss W. Noordyk and other former nurses from Arabia also contributed for the building of the chapel.

In June 1965 Mrs. Sita Thambiah, joined as an Evangelist. She helped conduct Friday morning open air service for leprosy patient, Evening prayers in hospital

wards and in selling of Bibles and Scripture portions to interested patients.

In the later years there were a number of chaplains who took care of the spiritual activities and the chapel services. As the hospital, over the past decade, rose up from dire circumstances, the chapel served as a sanctuary for the hopeful SMH community. In faith the SMH community came to the chapel holding steadfast onto the promises of God. The chapel never ceased to function all through the years as a center for worship, prayer and festivity.

REDEDICATION OF RENOVATED CHAPEL

Ortho. TKR Workshop - Training Program

The Orthopedic Department at Scudder Memorial Hospital hosted an extensive training program on 24.07.2024 aimed at enhancing the skills and knowledge of operation theatre staff nurse, surgical unit staff nurse, Ortho technicians and physiotherapist on the subject of Total Knee Replacement (TKR) headed by the Head of the Department and Medical Superintendent **Dr. Anbu Suresh Rao.** This initiative, which had a participation from 72 attendees, was designed to address the evolving needs and complexities associated with TKR procedures.



The training began with a series of in-depth lectures and presentations led by experienced Orthopaedic surgeons and nursing specialists. These sessions covered a wide range of topics related to TKR, including the latest advancements in surgical techniques, preoperative assessment, intraoperative management, and postoperative care. Emphasis was placed on understanding the indications for TKR, the nuances of surgical approaches, and the importance of post-surgical rehabilitation.

A significant component of the training was the saw bone workshop, which provided a hands-on learning experience. During this workshop, both doctors and operation theatre staff had the opportunity to work with simulated bones, allowing them to practice various surgical techniques and familiarize themselves with the procedural tools used in TKR. This practical component was instrumental in bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and real-world application, giving participants valuable insights into the complexities of the procedure.

The program also included interactive discussions and Q&A sessions where participants could engage directly with experts. These discussions facilitated a deeper understanding of challenging scenarios and allowed staff to address specific concerns or uncertainties they might have encountered in their clinical practice.

To gauge the effectiveness of the training, participants were asked to complete evaluations and provide feedback. This process helped in assessing the knowledge gained and the overall impact of the workshop on their clinical skills. The feedback also provided valuable insights for refining future training programs.

The training program at Scudder Memorial Hospital successfully equipped the operation theatre staff, surgical unit staff nurse, physiotherapist, and ortho technicians with enhanced skills and knowledge in Total Knee Replacement. By combining theoretical education with practical hands-on experience through the saw bone workshop, the program aimed to improve procedural competence and ultimately



contribute to better patient outcomes. The engagement of 72 participants underscores the commitment of the hospital to continuous professional development and the advancement of Orthopaedic surgical practices.

ORS Week

World ORS week (25 Jul - 31 July) was celebrated at SMH on 29th July at Paediatric OPD. The theme for this year was BLESSING FOR LIFE. It started with a word of prayer.
