Developmental Milestones to continue the Scudder Healing Ministry (2010-2024)

Since 1866, the Scudder Memorial Hospital, Ranipet stands as a beacon of light, bringing the poor, underprivileged and deprived people of our community to the Great Physician, the Saviour of the World.

Rev. Dr. John Scudder and his wife Mrs. Harrier Scudder, in 1819, sacrificially sowed the seed of the Preaching, Teaching and Healing Ministry. In 1866, his son Dr. Silas Scudder opened the Scudder Memorial Hospital at Ranipet, where over forty-seven members of the Scudder Family have continued in the Healing Ministry of our Lord Jesus Christ.

We thankfully remember the selfless and yeoman service of Indian Missionaries Dr. Julius Savarirayan, Dr. Ernest Baskar, Dr. Suguna Chandrashekar, Dr. Ruben Jesudas, Dr. Prema David, Dr. Mary Vijaya, Dr. Abraham Isaac, Dr. Chitra, Dr. David Sadhu, Dr. Jai Singh, Dr. G. Samraj who have carried and passed on the **Torch of the Healing Mission.**

From the year 2009 to 2010, the Hospital suffered from lack of leadership, dearth of finances and human resource to carry on the ministry. The hospital was staffed with only five Doctors, a meager number of outpatients and an Inpatients bed occupancy of only 15%. Salaries to over 200 employees was pending and outstanding bills to be cleared of over ninety-three lakhs.

In prayer and with complete trust and obedience, we received the promise,

"Not by Might, Nor by Power, but by my Spirit, says the Lord of Hosts" Zechariah 4:6

By the Grace of God, we have overcome several hurdles and established the essential clinical facilities to serve the poor and needy people. The Accident and Emergency Unit with SARI Bay, Six Modular Operation Theatres, 18 Bedded Private Surgical Suite with 3 bedded HDU, 13 Bedded Dialysis Unit, 6 bedded HDU, 2 bedded PICU, 16 Slice CT Scan, Cath. Lab, Maxillofacial and Craniofacial Unit are the major achievements in the past 14 years.

The 3rd of September, **Rev. Dr. John Scudder's** birthday has been celebrated as **Hospital Day** since 2010. The new clinical specialities, medical equipment or building construction are inaugurated on 3rd September each year in loving memory of the Founder of this 200 years old Healing, Teaching and Preaching Mission

The School of Nursing successfully completed **100 years of Nursing Education** (1921 - 2021). **A Centenary Souvenir** was released to mark the occasion. Over 2500 Nurses have been trained at the School of Nursing to care, serve, heal and spread God's Love. The sacrificial services of former Deans, Principals and Faculties of our School of Nursing were remembered and honoured.

By the Grace of God, we received the Government Order to start the Scudder College of Nursing in 2018 with minority status after few years of struggle and hardship to admit 25 students under Management quota and 25 students under Government quota. The Bishop & Officers of CSI Vellore Diocese kindly accepted our request and granted permission to utilize the Beattie Memorial Teaching (BMT) Institute's class rooms and the hostel rooms to accommodate our B. Sc. Nursing Students.

New Student Nurses' Hostel (G+2 Floors) in loving memory of Mrs. Noordyk was constructed to accommodate the nursing students. The 50-seater and 40-seater buses have been purchased for the use of nursing students to visit the community health centers. A modular kitchen with boilers was installed in 2022.

God has been gracious to start the two-year Post Basic B. Sc. Nursing Program from 2019 and two-year Auxiliary Nurse and Midwife (ANM) program from 2024. Over 120 trained nurses are graduating each year from our college.

PARAMEDICAL DIPLOMA COURSES SINCE 1981

The one-year Paramedical Diploma in Medical Laboratory Course was started four decades ago in 1981. The one year Diploma course was upgraded to Two Year Course from 1994 onwards. Two more courses were started in 2013 viz., Diploma in Medical Records Technology and Diploma in Radio Diagnosis Technology.

The Institute of Scudder Allied Health Science Unit was established in 2014 and in 2018 several other CMAI - Two Year Diploma Courses like Diploma in Orthopaedic Technician Course, Diploma in Dialysis Technology, Diploma in Anesthesia & Critical Care Technology were started followed by Diploma in Optometry and Ophthalmic Technology Course in 2019.

Having excelled in training, Allied Health Professionals with advanced knowledge and skills, the Institute widened in 2019 by commencing two Allied Health Science Bachelor Degree Courses viz., B. Sc. Medical Laboratory Technology and B. Sc. Radiography & Imaging Technology affiliated under the Tamil Nadu MGR Medical University, Chennai.


ED Workshop

The Emergency Department at Scudder Memorial Hospital (SMH) is committed to fostering academic growth and encouraging the teaching and learning of modern emergency medicine for emergency doctors, ED nurses, and paramedics.

On October 19, 2024, the Department of Emergency Medicine organized a preconference workshop on mechanical ventilation.



This one-day workshop focused on mechanical ventilation techniques and their application in the emergency room



The event was a great success, training approximately 35 participants, including doctors and paramedics from outside institutions. This workshop served as a precursor to the upcoming Emergency Medicine Conference in Chennai, scheduled for November 7-9, organized by the Society of Emergency Medicine India (SEMI)













Radiation Safety Workshop

Radiation safety is a concern for patients, physicians, and staff in many departments, including Radiology, Interventional Cardiology, and Orthopedics.

Radiation protection aims to reduce unnecessary radiation exposure with a goal to minimize the harmful effects of ionizing radiation. Three methods of radiation protection are time, distance and shielding.



This training enlighted about dose limits of radiation and various deterministic and stochastic effects of radiation. They were also educated about the usage of TLD badge and personal protective equipment. The session was led by Dr. Madhavi, Associate Professor from CMC vellore.
